From the News we learn the particulars of a suicide which occurred in this county last week. It appears from the evidence submitted to the coroner's inquest, held by Wm. Moreland, J. P., that deceased was born in Elbach, Switzerland; that her maiden name was Eliza Mosher; that she was at times laboring under temporary aberration of mind; and that during one of these attacks, last Friday morning, she took a fatal dose of strychnine, from which death resulted in about forty-five minutes. The jury in this case reported a verdict of death by poisoning during temporary aberration of mind. Deceased was a native of Switzerland, and was the youngest of nine children of three years.
