The New York Evening Post has been engaged in collecting some very interesting information relating to the foreign fruit trade in this country, and the statisties which it fur nishes show the importations are far larger than generally believed. The receipts at the port of N w York for the first quarter of the esent year, ending March 31, are in excess of those of the me period last year. Prices, how wer, have raled low, and the trade has been somewhat depressed, owing to the extremely cold weather of February and March. From the West Indies there were thirteen cargo sof oranges imported during the months of Janmary, February and March. The total number of barrels was 18,194, containing 10,101,787 ranges, of which 1,791,033 have per shed on the voyage, a loss of over for reseven per cent. From the Mediter nean there were received 251,589 boxes and cases [INDERSOLD IN THE STATE OF OREGON. containing 91,121,385 oranges, on which the loss was thirty-five per cent. This makes over a hundred million oranges received in New York during the three months ending March 31 of the present year. Over 24,000,000 lemons were received in the same time. Of bananas, the total number was 325,238 bunches, and the eccounuts footed up 1,780,-301 The total value of green fruit annot be beaten in quality of price. It would be useless for me to tell you all the mentioned was \$841,500, and the duty thereon \$154,437. Philadelphia received 73,030 boxes and cases of oranges, and 19,003 boxes of lemons. 


