The History of Creation.
Professor Ogden Loomis, an eminent
surgeon of Oregon City and of New
York, delivered in the city, lately,

a lecture on the history of creation,
which was more than passing interest
to each of the gorgeous spheres which
are familiar to us.

There are irregularities in the surface of each of
these, and all are surrounded by a
gaseous envelope. In the moon this
is faint, but in some of the planets
it is very bright.

That it is not water, as in the
changes of water and snow on our
planet. These bodies are round
because they were once fluid.

The theory is that the earth was in a
liquid state from the influence of
heat. That it is now water is
evident from the fact that the heat
decreases as we descend into the earth

and from geysers, earthquakes and
volcanoes. But it was not merely
light; it was in a gaseous condition.
The gas is subject to gravitation
and varies in weight; they expand
when heated and are contracted by
cold; they are non-conductors of
heat and retract light.

Besides this, they possess a magnetic
tendency and are either magnetic
or diamagnetic. They also possess
chemical power, as is shown when
oxygen supports combustion, and from
the decomposing qualities of chlorine.

One of the most curious facts in
astronomy is that the stars are
constantly changing in position, and
that the distance between them is
increasing.
