Double Tragedy. D. Harvey of Milwaukee Shoots his Mother, and then Sends a Bullet through his own Body.

Yesterday morning D. Harvey, of Milwaukee shot his mother while she was lying in bed beside her husband, then placed the pistol in his own hand, and put an end to his own life, falling in a pool of blood beside the bed. The particulars in brief are as follows: He rose at an early hour, went and milked, then returned to the house and undressed after which he took a new revolver and descended to the room in which his mother, Mrs. Mary Ann Burnett was sleeping and shot her over the body of her husband, then shot himself. Mr. Burnett being dead did not hear the report, but at 6 o'clock awoke, and attempted to arouse his wife. Finding he got up and discovered Dan lying in a pool of blood beside the bed. He rushed out and called help. X. B. Harvey hurried to the scene at the tragedy, but nothing could be done. Both lingered till about nine when they died within few minutes of each other. The cause was undoubtedly insanity.
