At the Pont du Jour the insurgents tried to creet a citudel, but Fort Valerein threw six forty-pound shells a minute and totally destroyed the work.

Spics report 30,000 Nationals ready to support the Versaillists troops, but only when they enter Paris. The anger of the troops against the insurgents is in conceivable. Our troops refuse quarter, and it is uscless for officres to urge mercy.

EASTERN NEWS.

New York, May 2 .- A Washington spo cial says: Notwithstanding the secree; members of the Joint High Commissio have professed in regard to points of the treaty negotiations, there is no doubt it provides for the recognition of claims of Englishmen for damages during our civil war; that money compensation will be given for use of the Canadian fishing grounds; that navigation of the St. Lawrence will be free to our vessels; also, navigation of Canadian canals, being bound only to pay toll. The San Juan boundary question is not yet fully settled. We shall prohably get all we claim in that direction. The close reticence displayed by Earl De Gray and English members, is not so strictly maintained by our own side. Our correspondent says prominent points of treaty are that our demands for indemnity for depredations by the Alabama, are conceded ; Englishmen in this country who suffered by our civil war are to be indemnified ; also, our fishermen to have the privilege of remming fishing, on payment of a certain sum as compensation therefor by the United States. It should be remembered, however, that damages to Englishmen are estimated at some \$20,000,000 more than our estimate of damagas by the Alabama.

Washington, May 2 .-- General Crook has, by special order of the President, been assigned to the command of the Department of Arizona, in place of General Stone-

New York, May 3 .- A special says: The first step towards the execution of the Ku Kinx law will probably be the issue of a proclamation by the President, which may be expected in a very short time, calling attention to the provisions of the law, the purpose to enforce it thoroughly and promptly wherever it may be violated. There is considerable evidence of the good moral effects of this law in suppressing disorders of the South already.

A Special Washington dispatch says the Haytien Minister has been authorized by his Government to state that Hayti does not desire to conquer and control the Dominican Republic, but that it only object h to establish a boundary line between Hayti and Dominica. It would be pleased if a boundary could be guaranteed by the Gorernment of the United States. The Haytien Minister here has had the report of the San Domingo Commissioners translated in to the Spanish language, with a view of distributing it in that form in Hayti and Europe.


