

Gas Available Will Get Workers to Camp

Side Trips Week-ends May Be Thing of Past

H. H. Britzman, northwest coordinator and representative of the Petroleum Conservation board of the Federal government in Seattle, said Tuesday that he is confident the gasoline rationing card system will take care of Camp Adair workers in the matter of sufficient gasoline to get to and from work. Mr. Britzman expressed this feeling in a telephone conversation with H. C. (Sven) Johnson, coordinator here.

That there will be plenty of gasoline for pleasure and other driving not directly connected with getting to and from work at Camp Adair, is a wrong assumption, Mr. Britzman said.

"A large number of workers here who live outside the area, have been driving home week ends," said Mr. Johnson following the telephone talk. "Although these trips

may seem necessary to the individuals themselves, still this extra travel is not directly a part of carrying on the defense project of building Camp Adair. Workers must be ready to curtail these outside trips following the rationing card issue.

"There seems to be no doubt that there will be sufficient gasoline for workers to get to work and return home. The cards will take care of this need, but farther than that, supplies will be problematical," Mr. Johnson said.

The coordinator believes that workers here should prepare their schedules to conform to the above suggestions, which will almost surely go into practice with the issuance of gasoline cards by June 1.

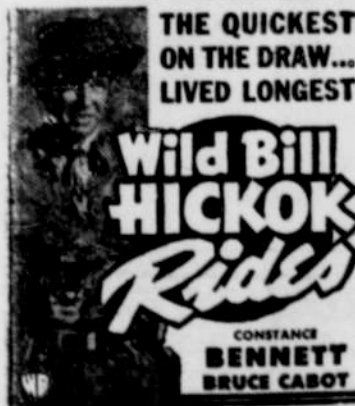
