Training Given Free By Federal Agencies

Workers who are finishing their jobs at Camp Adair-and their wives-may now get training fo the free classes in welding being conducted on a 24 -hour basis both conducted on a 24 -hour basis both in
Albany and Corvallis. These classes in vocational training, financed by the federal government, offer an opportunity for non-defense workers to transfer
from their jobs to vital defense infrom their jobs to vital defense in
dustries. Shifts in the schedule of classes are planned so that workers may take the training and still hold their present jobs. Shipyard jobs are then available after $2^{2 / 1 / 2}$
to five weeks training, depending on individual ability and the num ber of hours per day spent in training.
A total of 9000 welders are expected from the training centers en may also enroll in these welding classes.
Instruction in ship joinery and marine electricity is also available
