Although necessary orders have not yet come through military channels, here is what will be necessary for you when these orders reach Camp Adair:


First, ration ticket No. 17 will get you a pair of shoes at any store-if you have the money and

It is the only form on which service men can buy shoes outside of quartermaster sales.

Local rationing boards have no authority to grant certificates, but they must come from the "Issuing Officer" of the army.

NOVENA FOR VICTORY OPENS IN CHAPEL NO. 8 SUNDAY

Last Sunday afternoon hundreds of members of the Timber Wolf Division crowded into Chapel No. 8, North 5th and C Streets, for the opening of the world famous "Novena of Our Lady of Sorrows for Victory." A novena is a nine days' devotion at which special prayers are said by the congregation for some special favor. It is seven years since the original Novena of Sorrows service was initiated in a Chicago Church at which time 3000 parishioners under the direction of Rev. Jas. Keane, O.S.M. gathered in prayer for the opening ceremony. Today, rive years later, the Novena has been instituted in every state of the union and in several foreign countries. Recently the service has been established In several army camps and the spirit of the novena has been apoted by hundreds of thousands of soldiers in our armed forces.

The Novena in Chapel 8 was opened by Chaplain Edmund Murray who las May initiated the pray ers at Camp Barkeley, Texas. Although the chief petition offered in the Camp Adair Novena is for a just peace and complete victory for our allies, novenites at each service sign petition slips requesting other favors through the intercession of our Lady of Sorrows in whose honor the prayers are conducted. Since the novena began in 1937 more than eight million petitions have been signed and al though no numerical computation of prayers answered is yet complete, thousands of novenites, Prot estant, Catholic and Jewish, have flooded the offices of the Novena Office in Chicago with letters atfor such favors as cures from illess, conversion to God, happines in marriage, employment, financial aid, success in business, etc.

The traditional day for the novna service in civilfan communi ties is Friday, but inasmuch as the pressure of army duties prevents the soldiers from attending the regular week-day services the Army Chaplain by special dispensation may hold the Novena on any day of the week, hence the choice of Sunday afternoon in Chapel 8.

ANSWER BOX

Q. To settle an argument, can you tell us whether the U. S. pays captured enemy officers?

No. Only enlisted men of the fourth, fifth, sixth and seventh grades in the army, navy, marine orps, or the coast guard, includng any and all retired and reserve components of such servces, are entitled to receive a nonthly family allowance for any period during which such enlisted san is in active military service of the U.S. on or after June 1 1942, during the existence of any war declared by congress and the

ix months immediately following. Q. In order for a serviceman to obtain an allowance for a wife and child under the Servicemen's Dependents Allowance Act, does he save to submit proof that they are inancially dependent upon him for

A. No. It is not necessary to prove that they are dependent, ut it is necessary to show relaonship by submitting the proof. Q. I'm an alien and would like to know if I can ever rise above the grade of private. I'm waiting for my final citizenship papers.

A. Sure. You can be promoted up to the grade of master sergeant, if you're qualified. After receiving your final citizenship papers you will be eligible for OSC.
