"We tee off with tennis racquets and putt with broomsticks," Moore says of the Octoberfest. "It's a lot of fun." Membership fee is \$53 a year for the women and \$50 for the men, \$33 of which goes to

the Oregon Golf Association. Both the men and women play by OGA/U.S. Golf Association rules. The women play Tuesday mornings, either nine or 18 holes, while the men play at 5 p.m. Tuesdays (nine holes) and 8 a.m. Thursdays (18 holes). The two groups also play nice together.

"We do some social things," says Moore. "We did a men's and women's scramble for Food Share, and raised \$300 for Food Share last year." Membership in the associations has been helped by the purchase of the course in March 2012 by Three Rivers Casino and Hotel, which has invested in some noticeable

improvements to the course. "The casino has been doing things to make the course more playable," says Jerry Mulvey, longtime treasurer for the men's association. "It's been a big help to membership." "I love this golf course," adds Tommy Thompson, a PGA professional who offers lessons at Ocean Dunes.

degrees in the next few days." The turtle's journey through recovery is just beginning;

there is still a significant chance she may not make it. If she does, she will need several months of rehabilitation before she is healthy enough to be released in her warmer, native

waters to the south. Caring for wild, distressed animals is an important part of the aquarium's mission. According to Burke, "Through wildlife rehabilita-

tion, we humanely help suffering animals. In the case of threatened and endangered species, we also hope to boost these critical populations in their recovery."

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service urges anyone who finds a sea turtle on the beach to contact the Oregon State Police Wildlife Hotline at 800-452-7888 to ensure appropriate
