Incumbent Jay Bozievich will not face a runoff election against opponent Dawn Lesley for West Lane County commissioner, according to the certified recount results released by Lane County


Elections on June 19. Bozievich received 7,708 votes compared to Lesley's 7,634, enough to prevent a runoff in the fall.
