The Disabled American Veterans are a part of the Veterans Affairs (VA), bill WD 5398, that was signed in 1930 by President Herbert Hoover. The bill consolidated federal veterans programs and elevated them to a federal administration.

As noted in the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs history, "The United States has the most comprehensive system of assistance to veterans of roots that can be traced back to 1636, when the Pilgrims of Plymouth Colony were at war with the Pequot Indians.
