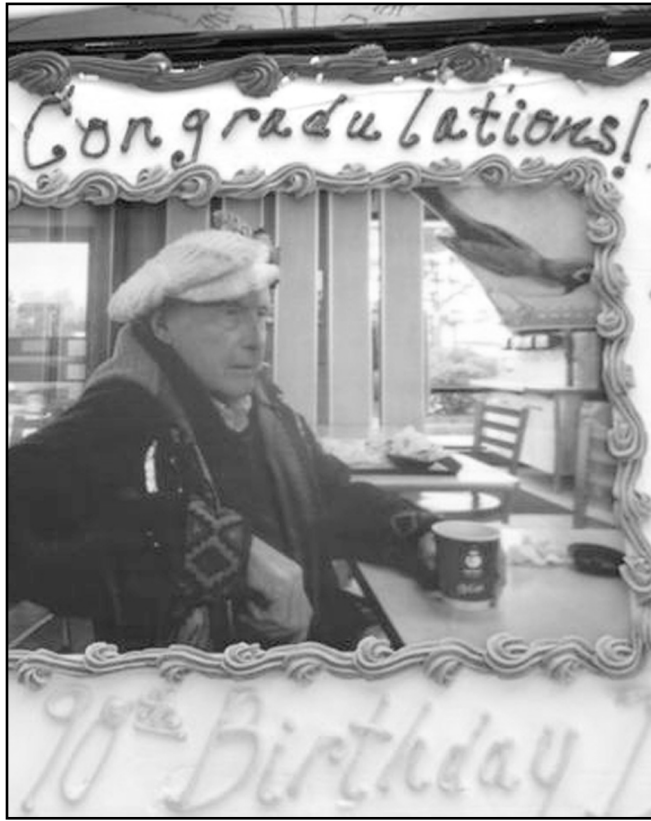
Jan. 13

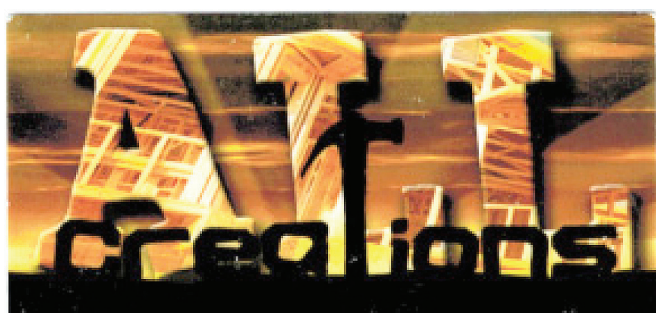
