#### **MID COAST LAKES:**

The rainbow trout stocking program will begin in many mid coast lakes in early February. Be sure to check out the 2015 stocking schedule for the most up to date information. Fishing for the various warm water fish species can still be productive during the winter months but anglers may need to target different areas of a lake (typically deeper) versus when fishing in the spring or summer.

**ALSEA RIVER:** Steelhead

The winter steelhead fishery has produced fair to good results recently. This week should be productive in the mid to lower reaches of the river while flows are low and river temperatures are warming.

## Lady Viks nab first league win

Boys' team narrowly falls to Lancers in final minutes, 42-38

It took less than a quarter for the Viking girls (1-2) to get the upper hand over visiting South Umpqua (0-3) last Friday, thanks to solid scoring Tatum and dominant rebounding from senior Halee Richards and sophomore Elyssa Rose.

Ahead 13-2 to start the second quarter, the Viking breezed to a 55-24 win to pick up their first Far West win and move into a three-way tie for third place with Marshfield and North Bend (1-2).

Tatum led scoring with 10 points for the Vikings. Richards had nine points and 12 rebounds. Rose had seven points and four blocked shots against the Lancers.

That same night, Douglas and

from sophomore forward Destinie Brookings (3-0), defeated North Bend and Marshfield, respectively.

> The Viking boys, meanwhile, fell behind early but battled back in the second half to take a six-point lead heading into the final period.

The Lancers then went on a 13-3 scoring run in the last three minutes to move ahead and hold on to a narrow 42-38 win over Siuslaw.

Last night, the Vikings were at home to host Douglas (after press deadlines).

Friday, Siuslaw will be at North Bend. Girls play at 6 p.m., followed by the boys' game at 7:30 p.m.
