"Fraudulent attempts are on the rise and we're working to stop fraud where we find it," explained the department's director, Jim Bucholz.

Bucholz attributes the current detection of fraudulent attempts to the business rules and processes in use by the department.

Staff are reviewing and verifying the validity of a number of returns. The department may contact victims of identity theft. The department is working with TurboTax-developer Intuit to determine the extent of the impact on Oregon taxpayers.

"If we can identify victims of fraud early, it's easier for us to help them," Bucholz said. If you've received notifica-
