

## Ask Dr. Paul

Dear Dr. Paul:

How do I know if my tires are properly inflated?

#### Sign me, Tired of Wondering

The right PSI (pounds per square inch) varies from car to car. PSI information can be found on a sticker in the glove compartment or inside the driver's door. Check tire pressure when car is cold. Never let air out of tires that are hot. When tires heat up, pressure increases, so if you let air out and the car cools, the pressure will be wrong.
