Hilarity ensues and if you want to know the rest, you'll just have to come see the show.

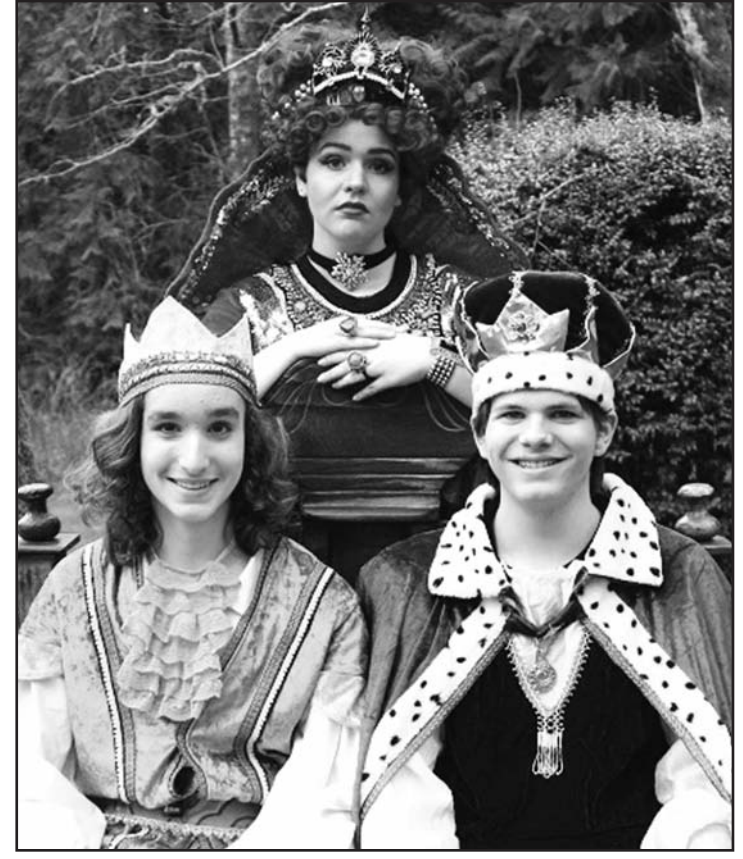

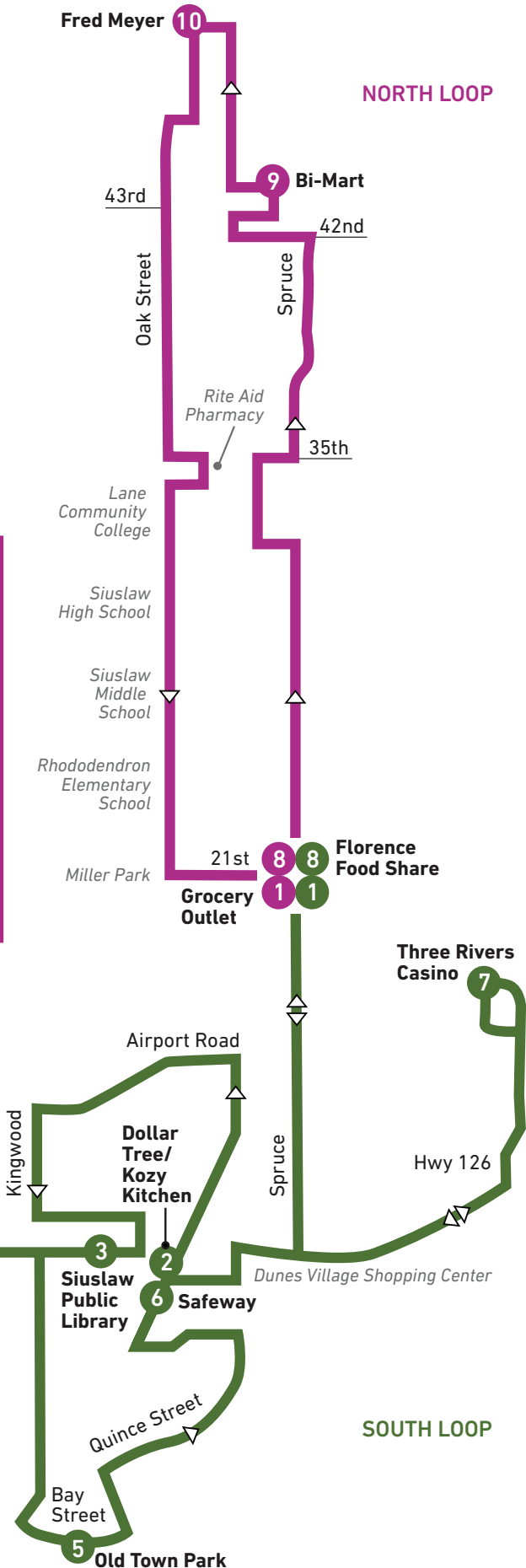

Additional service changes include those listed below

- The bus stays on Oak Street after the Fred Meyer and Rite Aid Pharmacy.
- The bus stops at the corner of Airport Road and Kingwood near the Senior Center. It no longer stops at the Senior Center parking lot.
- The bus travels in both directions on 9th Street to serve Greentrees and Peace Harbor Hospital.
- Rhododendron Drive between 9th Street and Kingwood is no longer a part of the route.
