

Florence Food Share is an emergency food box pantry serving the town of Florence and the Dunes City/ Westlake area. We distribute close to 50,000 pounds of food every month. An average of 1650 individuals come through our pantry for services each month and 30% of those we serve are under the age of 18. Because of the volume of food we distribute, we must constantly replenish our shelves.

Our most needed items are: sugar, flour, Rice-a-Roni, Hamburger Helper, coffee, canned meats, baby food, baby and adult diapers, and canned tomato products.

Florence Food Share is grateful for the ongoing support of this community. Because of your generosity, Food Share continues to thrive.
