

Bozievich, Mokrohisky to speak at City Club May 1

On Friday, May 1, the Florence City Club invites the public to join West Lane County Commissioner Jay Bozievich and Lane County Administrator Steve Mokrohisky for a discussion on the proposed vehicle registration fee on the May ballot.

Lane County voters will decide whether they want to adopt a \$35 vehicle registration increase to be dedicated to the maintenance of roads, bridges and highways.

If it is approved, 40 percent of the funds will be shared with incorporated cities to keep city streets well maintained. The measure also provides for citizen oversight and an annual independent audit.
