## Haven't received your ballot yet?

Lane County ballots were mailed on Friday, May 1. Most registered voters should have received their ballots by now.

Voters who do not receive their ballot in the mail by Tuesday, May 5, should do one or more of the following:

Visit [www.lanecounty.org/elections](http://www.lanecounty.org/elections) to confirm the voter is registered to vote.

If a voter has moved, even

to just the apartment next door, the voter will need to update his or her registration.

A voter can do this online at [www.lanecounty.org/elections](http://www.lanecounty.org/elections) if he or she has a valid DMV license, identification card or permit number. The link can also be used to update or remove a mailing address.

A voter can also complete a

registration card and mail or deliver it to Lane County Elections.

Ballots cannot be forwarded by law. Oregon's vote-by-mail system allows for voters to request an absentee ballot at a temporary location if a voter is not going to be at their permanent address.

Lane County Elections staff is here to help. Voters

can contact elections staff at 541-682-4234.

Lane County Elections is located at 275 W. 10th Ave., on the corner of 10th and Lincoln streets in downtown Eugene.

The office is open from 9 a.m. to noon, and 1 to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday.

On Election Day, May 19, the office will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
