Master Recyclers offer this service to the community to reduce the use of disposable paper and plastic ware, which end up in the landfill.

Using durable tableware saves you money — both in not having to purchase paper or plastic dishes and in reduced garbage volume, and it helps the environment, too.

Plus, the retro dish patterns are a guaranteed conversation starter. Who wouldn't prefer to use a sturdy plate and real cutlery, rather than flimsy plastic forks and paper plates?

To reserve tableware for your next event, just call the number listed above. A Master Recycler will help you complete a one-page loan agreement form and arrange with you to pick up and return the dishware.

The Durable Dishware program works on the honor system, with borrowers returning dishes in a clean condition and replacing any lost

Q. My neighbor told me I can take some items to City Hall for recycling, that I can't put in my home recycling bin. Where do I take them and what is

A. Your neighbor is correct. There is a small, self-serve recycling center in the lobby of Florence City Hall, at 250 Highway 101.

An informative bulletin board above the recycle tubs lists acceptable and unacceptable items, including an easy to understand Yes/No display with photographs and examples.

Currently accepted items include: ink cartridges; recyclable batteries no alkaline batteries, those go in the trash; cell phones and batteries including rechargeable batteries such as those used for cordless drills, cameras, laptops, etc.; cork - finally, a home for that wine cork collection, no synthetic corks, please; pill bottles - remove labels with personal information and lids; plastic caps — such as those that twist on with a threaded neck (shampoo, water, soda, milk, laundry detergent, pill bottles, etc.) and flip-top caps like those commonly used on ketchup bottles; no margarine container lids, coffee cup lids or caps with metal parts.

A dedicated City of Florence volunteer regularly delivers these materials to where they can be recycled.

Florence Master Recyclers are part of the Lane County Master Recycler Program, a service of the County's Public Works Waste Management Division since 2002. The mission of the MR program is to bridge the gap between awareness and action by motivating people to reduce solid waste at home, work and play.
