

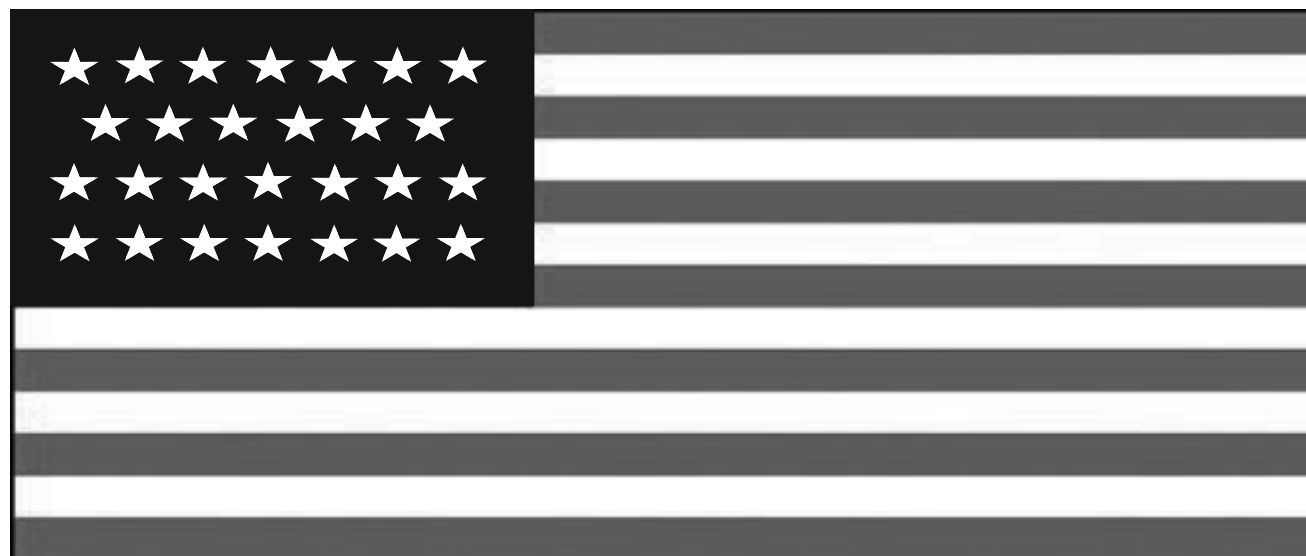
**26 Star Flag
8th Official U.S. Flag
July 4, 1837**

The 26-Star Flag: This Flag became the Official United States Flag on July 4th, 1837. A star was added for the admission of Michigan (January 26th, 1837) and was to last for 8 years. The four Presidents to serve under this flag were; Martin Van Buren (1837-1841), William Henry Harrison (1841), John Tyler (1841-1845) and James Polk (1845-1849).

Fact: William Henry Harrison was the only president who studied to become a doctor.

**27 Star Flag
9th Official U.S. Flag
July 4, 1845**

This Flag became the Official United States Flag on July 4th, 1845. A star was added for the admission of Florida and was to last for only 1 year. The only President to serve under this flag was James Polk (1845-1849).

Fact: James Polk survived a gallstone operation at the age of 17 without anesthesia or antiseptics. Practices were not used at that time.
