## Lane County jail earns top score on inspection

**EUGENE** — The Lane County Sheriff's Office is excited to report a 100 percent compliance rating on a jail inspection completed last week by the Oregon State Sheriffs' Association.

The inspection involved a multi-day, comprehensive review of jail practices, policies and procedures.

The inspection team rated the jail on 309 standards, referred to as the Oregon Jail Standards. The Jail Standards are a set of guidelines for best practices to improve the operation of jails, to decrease potential liability and to maintain a high level of staff professionalism. They cover all aspects of operating a correctional facility, including inmate management practices, inmate healthcare and facility security.

The inspection team made the following comment regarding the review of the Lane County Jail:

"During the course of our inspection we spoke with deputies, command staff and inmates. I am very pleased to

report that, overall, we found your facility to be operating well within the guidelines of the Oregon Jail Standards. We found your facility to be very orderly and well run."

The Oregon Jail Standards are guidelines developed by the Oregon State Sheriffs' Association in the 1990s after determining that the 14 statutes in the ORS that govern correctional facilities did not provide the detailed guidance necessary to cover all of the components of operating a jail.

Participation in the inspection program is voluntary, but provides agencies with valuable information on how to improve operations.

Jail Commander Dan Buckwald said, "We are excited and honored to have received such a high rating. This score is a testament to the hard work and dedication of the staff in the Adult Corrections Division, and to the community that has invested in the Sheriff's Office and expects the highest quality of service."

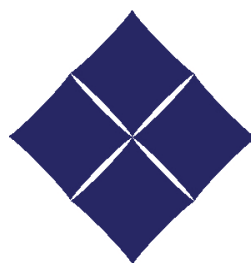
