The backlit, life-size cross in the sanctuary at St. Andrew's Episcopal Church gave a calm sense of presence to worshippers for more than 40 years.

Then, one day, the lights behind the cross no longer worked. When properties warden Paul Hirsh, sexton Willie Leach and congregant Bill McArdle took the cross down from its brackets to see what was wrong, they discovered that not only had the fluorescent bulbs burnt out, but the wiring was fried, too.

"I guess we were lucky that nothing bad happened," said Hirsch. After debating whether to leave the cross unlit, reinstall fluorescent bulbs, or go with LED strip lighting, the three handymen decided on the LED system, and removed the large cross to a banquet table in the church's adult seminar room, where it rested while the LED stripping was installed and other improvements were
