He also volunteered for the STEP program in his early years in Florence, as well as Florence City Police and Oregon State Police.

He loved animals and he and Danell's Jack Russell, Molly, loved to play ball and take walks around the neighborhood. He was a 32nd Degree Mason and a member of the First Baptist Church.

He is survived by his wife, Danell; two daughters: Kelly Sterling of Napa, Calif., and Kimberly Hughes of Smyrna, Tenn.; five grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.

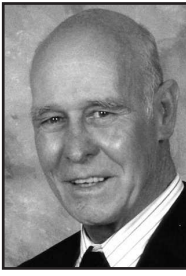

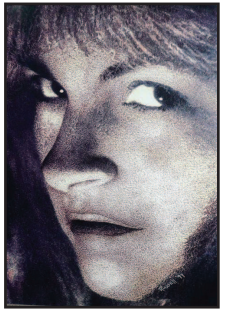
Please join Richard Russell, September 12th from 3:00-5:00 pm.
