elcome to the Fifth Annual Florence Festival of Books, a book fair for authors, publishers and readers. Here, books are celebrated real books with pages that you turn.

This year, we showcase the works of 83 authors whose writing covers a variety of genres and nine publishers ready to talk about their writers' books. This also is an opportunity to discuss publishing your own manuscript. We even have a display of books written by Siuslaw Elementary School students, our future authors.

This free event is your opportunity to meet and speak with the authors of great books. Each book you purchase can be personalized just for you or as a gift for someone else. For those who prefer to shop with a credit card, that's no problem; we're set up to handle them. When you arrive, be sure to pick up a free tote bag to

transport all your book purchases.

This year, the festival's Featured Readers area is sponsored by Banner Bank. We'll have 16 authors entertaining you with readings from their published work. You will have an opportunity to win a copy of the book at the end of each reading.

Then, join Keynote Speaker Jane Kirkpatrick at 7 p.m. on Friday. She is an award-winning, New York Times bestselling author known for her historical fiction and non-fiction books. Tickets for this event are \$8 in advance or \$10 at the door.
