SEAcoast Entertainment Association's first free community enrichment event for the 2015-16 season has been moved from Siuslaw High School to the Bromley Room at the Siuslaw Public Library.

The event will feature Latin Grammy-nominated Ouattrosound, an innovative

ensemble that blends pop, jazz and classical into a new genre the group calls "Popzzical."

The band's members will take questions, discuss and demonstrate their artistry on cello, violin, guitar and darbuka, a goblet-shaped drum common to North Africa and the Middle East.

Originally scheduled as an extra arts and music program for students, the engagement had to move due to a scheduling conflict with the school.

The free event will instead take place at 11:30 a.m. on Friday, Oct. 9. Students and the public are invited.

Quattrosound kicksoff SEAcoast's 2015-16 concert season at 7 p.m. that evening.

As part of their service to the community, SEAcoast books many of its performers to provide master classes for students, make visitations at senior care facilities or host public meet-and-greets in addition to their concerts.

Hailing from Japan, Mexico, Guatemala and Texas, the group's music is as broad as their ethnicities. According to their website, this innovative acoustic-based ensemble skillfully blurs the lines between music genres.

The members are equally astute at playing a classical piece by Bach as they are at covering Led Zeppelin or jazzfusion artist Chick Corea.

Individually, these L.A.based musicians have played with the likes of Bocelli, Barbara Streisand, Yo-Yo Ma, Annie Lennox, Michael Jackson, Layla Hathaway, Ricky Martin and Gloria Estefan.

Together, they create a unique musical experience with impressive technicality that brings audiences to their feet at every performance.

Music critics from across the described country have Quattrosound as "blindingly

talented," "Bursting with intellect, passion and virtuosity," and "Sounding like nothing you've heard before."




