He left Motorola to earn his masters degree at Arizona State University and later got an ABD in management science.

Merril did some rather novel

systems analysis work for the engineering department of Arizona Department of Transportation. Lastly, he fulfilled a promise to one of his first college professors to teach. After 10 years, Merrill retired to spend the rest of his years in Oregon.

There will be burial with his wife in a common urn after cremation, at Globe Mills Cemetery in Kreamer, Pa., where his wife's parents are buried.
