## Boat parade canceled, good will continues for Salvation Army

DUNES CITY — The first lighted boat parade scheduled to be held Saturday, Dec. 12, was canceled due to high winds and heavy rains that drowned the Oregon coast last weekend.

Still, nearly 50 people gathered at Darlings Marina and RV Resort at Siltcoos Lake.

"Our lighted boats all stayed ashore due to the hazardous conditions, but the weather did not drown our spirts," says Rich Olson, co-owner of the resort, "We managed to raise nearly \$1,300 for Home Front War Relief, a program of The Salvation Army serving veterans and their families."

Lori Olson prepared a delicious spaghetti dinner that helped raise most of the money. Other moneys came from donations collected by Old Town Barber Shop owner Geraldine Lucio, who hosts the Red Kettle in Old Town this year on Bay Street.

General Manager Cajun Olson, who served a great deal of Christmas cheer in the form of beverages, donated all the tips and proceeds from the sales of drinks to the fundrais-

The Community Chorus of Florenceis seeking a permanent chorus director. Position applications will be accepted through Dec. 31.


Interviews and directing auditions will be held in early January with the position officially beginning Jan. 18, 2016.


