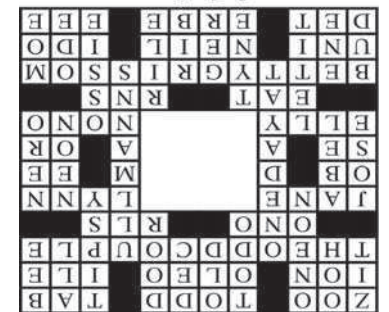
The 38th Annual Kennedy Center Honors
