

To perform or participate backstage, kids must attend the audition. Onstage performer hopefuls will need to bring 16-32 bars from a song that they would like to sing (sheet music or a CD, MP3 track with no background voices is also acceptable), and a headshot and resume if you have one.

Prospective cast members will also be taught a short dance combination, and those asked to come to callbacks will read sides from the script. Interested families are


