California man dies in Highway 101 accident

Oregon State Police (OSP) troopers responded to a fatal vehicle crash on Dec. 26 at about 11:45 a.m., at milepost 162 of Highway 101 in Yachats.

Preliminary information indicates that Allan Richard Schmidt, 94, from Fortuna, Calif., was operating a white 2006 Chevrolet Colorado pickup and traveling southbound.

For unknown reasons, the truck veered off the roadway and struck a utility pole off the southbound shoulder.

The Colorado then crossed over a private driveway and came to rest in thick brush west of the highway. Air bags were deployed and Schmidt was not wearing a safety belt.

Troopers pronounced him deceased at the scene.

OSP was assisted by Yachats Fire and Rescue, Lincoln County Sheriff's Office, Lincoln County District Attorney's Office, Lincoln County Medical Examiner and Oregon Department of Transportation.
