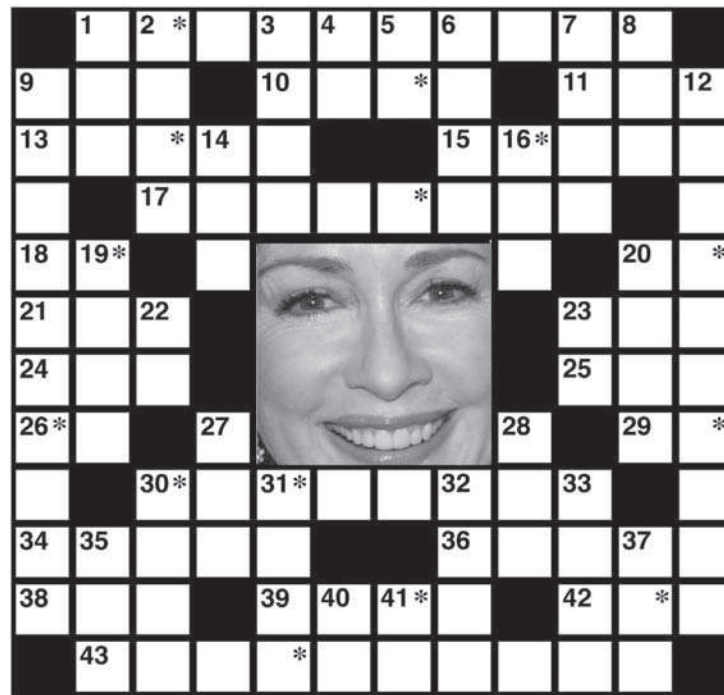


crossword fun

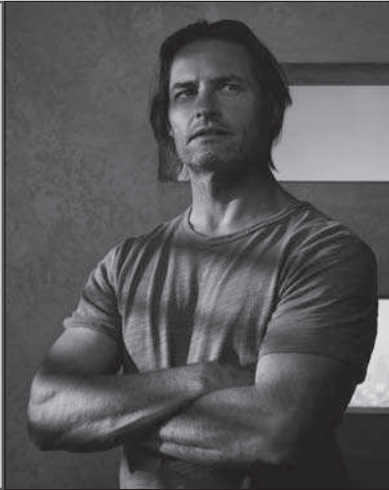
