Sunday at 9 p.m. on **HBO**

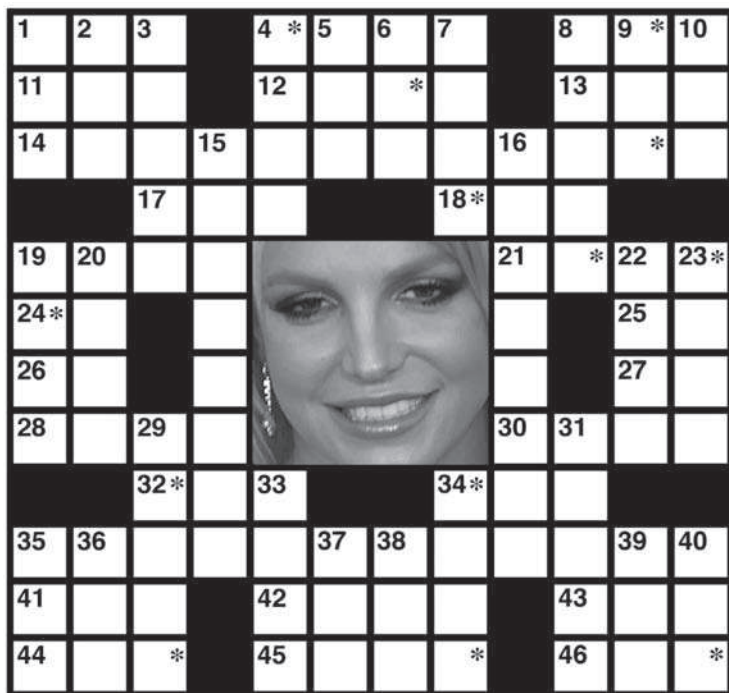

The low-key prequel to "Breaking Bad" returns for Season 2, having bagged seven Emmy nods for its first go-around, including best actor (Bob Odenkirk), best supporting actor (Jonathan Banks) and best drama series. As before, the primary focus is a character study of decent-guy attorney Jimmy McGill (Odenkirk) and how circumstances transformed him into the anything-for-a-buck shyster who works under the name Saul Goodman. Rhea Seehorn also stars.
