The market will also be filled with new lines of garden planters, tools, and fertilizers to help you put the "Oh!" in your organic garden and garden designs.

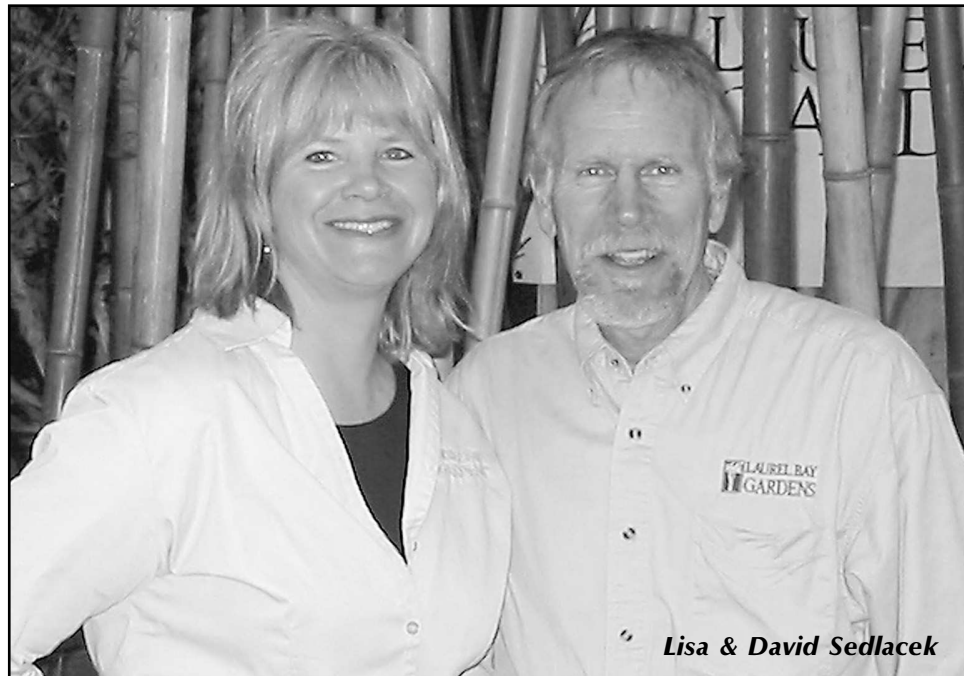

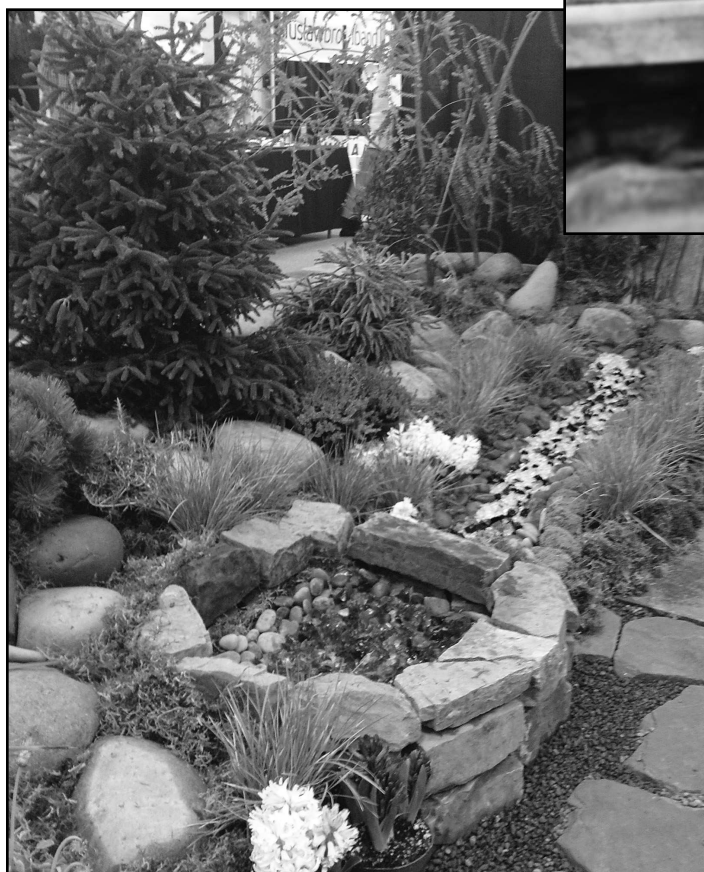

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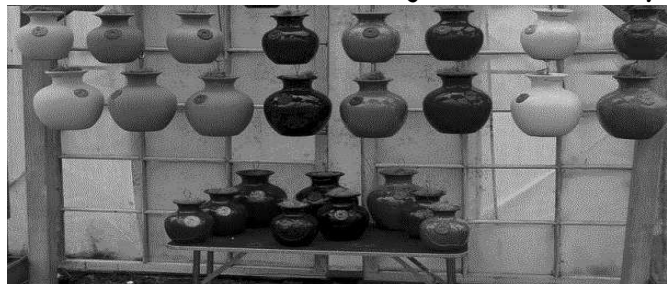
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
