They also have the poten data about driving behaviors such as car speed, braking and acceleration-and other information that many drive would prefer to remain private, such as locations you visit most often, radio usage, phone operation and even the number of people in your car.

Currently, automakers have almost exclusive access to your car's date, with the exception of some diagnostic infor mation. Terms of service agreed to by consumers at the time of sale or during service can allow for many types of
