Property tax return due March 15

SALEM — If you own a business, even a home-based business, Oregon law requires you file a yearly personal property tax return with your county assessor.

The deadline to file your return has changed. You must complete and return it to the

assessor, file it online, or postmark it on or before March 15.

Extensions are no longer available (House Bill 2484 amended ORS 308.290).

Personal property taxes are due Nov. 15.

Business owners must file a return each year. If a business

owner doesn't file, penalties vary from 5 percent to 50 percent of the taxes due, depending on when the return is filed.
