BABY BIRDS

Spring is here! Birds are one of the most common signs of spring's arrival. In early spring they begin building nests, laying eggs and hatching the next generation.

Since you can't raise a baby bird on your own, what should you do? Here are a few ideas:

Call a local wildlife _____ to help. They may take the bird and raise it properly.

With your parent's _____, put the bird back in its nest. (The old belief that mother birds won't accept a baby covered with a human's scent is false!)

If the bird is in an exposed area, coax it to move someplace that offers _____, such as under a bush. Some birds, including killdeer and some waterfowl, actually lay their eggs on the ground, so don't _____ about them!

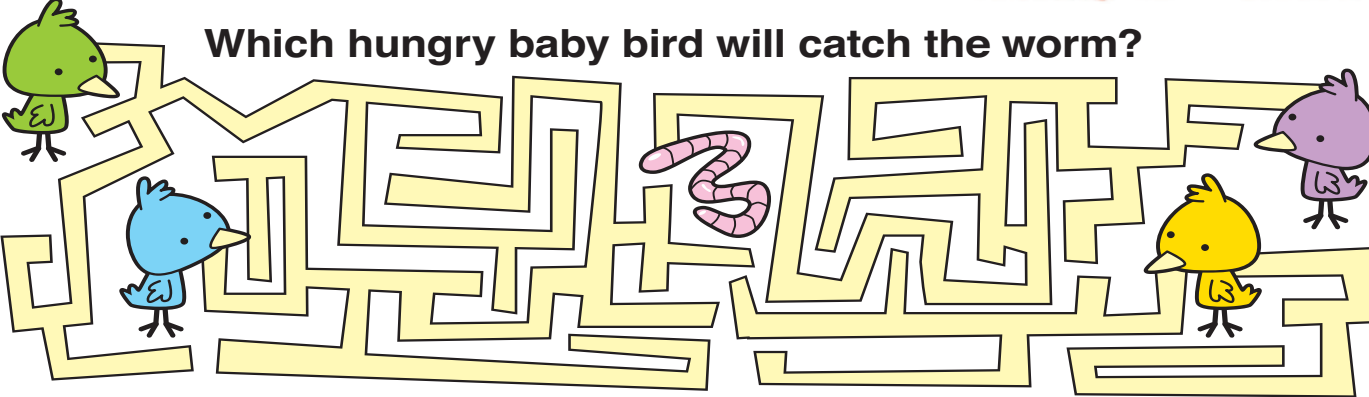
