Western Lane fire protection assessment meeting on Monday

A public meeting on recent Fire Protection Assessment additions in the Western Lane District is Monday, March 28, in Florence, at the Siuslaw Valley Fire main station, 2625 Highway 101.

The Oregon Department of Forestry's (ODF) Western Lane District will hold a town hall meeting with State Sen. Arnie Roblan, District 5, on Fire Protection Assessments for wildfire protection.

ODF will explain the assessment process to attendees and answer questions.

The department recently reviewed the existing Forest Patrol Assessments in the area around Florence and determined that 700 additional lots meet the definition of forestland for the purpose of wildfire protection.

The last review in the area was conducted more than a decade ago. The assessments are part of the funding structure for the wildland fire protection the agency provides. Accuracy of these assessment rolls is maintained by completing a periodic review of a portion of the district each vear.

ODF sent letters to the residents informing them that their properties would now be assessed. Whenever tax lots are added to the Forest Patrol Assessment, the total revenue received by the department does not increase.

Rather, the assessment paid by each landowner is more equitably distributed among those receiving wildland fire protection.

In addition to Sen. Roblan, Rep. Caddy McKeown, District 9, and Lane County Commissioner Jay Bozievich are likely to attend the town hall meeting to answer questions.

While this meeting is specific to questions for the ODF representatives, Sen. Roblan encouraged constituents to attend and give him a sense of what is on the minds of residents in and around Senate District 5.
