The prescription drug disposal drop box will be available to the public Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., in the lobby of the Florence Justice Center, at 900 Greenwood St.

This is a great way to safely dispose of your outdated or unused prescription and over the counter medications. Due to the construction of our box, and its relatively small size, do not package any containers together in

boxes or bags.

The box does not accept any liquid medications or sharps (used needles or lances).

The city hopes this convenient disposal option can help keep area families safe and the waterways clean in Florence.

This box is intended for use by the public, it is not intended for usage by commercial facilities.

Cordova — Ryves

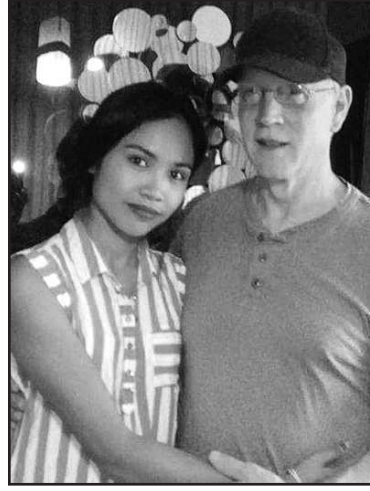
Robert Scott Ryves and **Juliana Lapiz Cordova** will be married in June of 2016.
