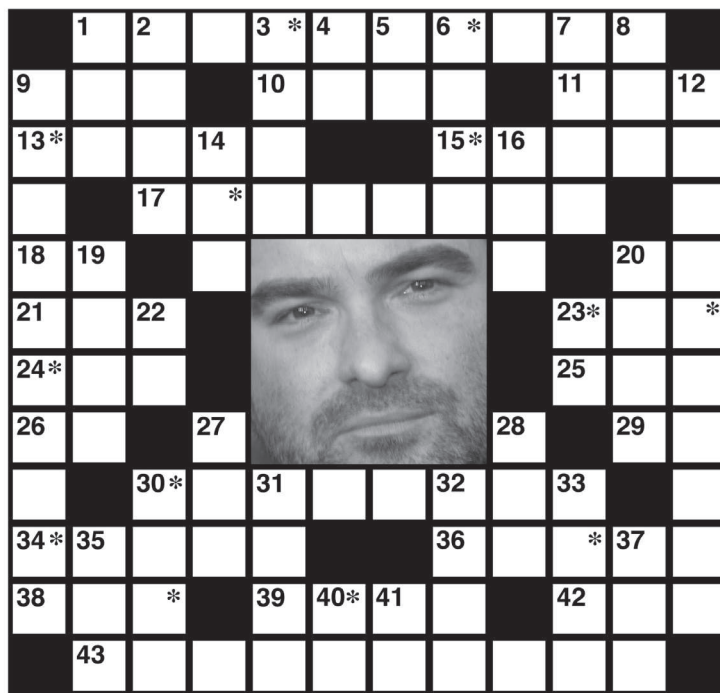


crossword fun
