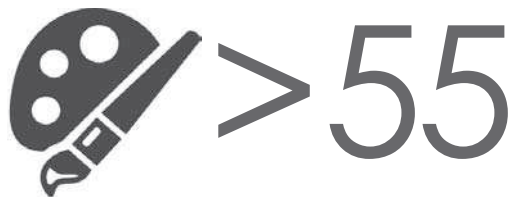
Card-carrying members of the Siuslaw Public Library. Our overall circulation numbers per patron place us in the top 17% of libraries nationwide for use and resources.

At any one time, the Siuslaw Public Library is displaying more than **55 pieces of art**. These pieces range from permanent pieces to work from local artists, and from educational displays to traveling exhibits. This public display of art is unparalleled in western Lane County.

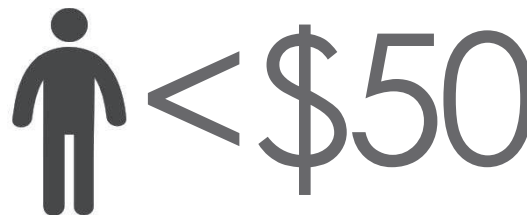
Caregivers, parents, and children had access to about **200 Library storytimes** for infants and toddlers in the last year. These storytimes teach vital early literacy and school readiness skills to the children of the Siuslaw Public Library District.



The Siuslaw Public Library District serves residents of the region with locations in both Florence and Mapleton. Our checkerboard District also serves the communities of Deadwood, Swisshome, and Dunes City and stretches out across a distance roughly equal to **2.5 times the size of Singapore**: in other words, 667 square miles.



Siuslaw Librarians answered more than **11,300 questions** last year. Every day, we help dozens of people conducting job searches, seeking computer assistance, in need of legal or medical information, or looking for their next favorite book.

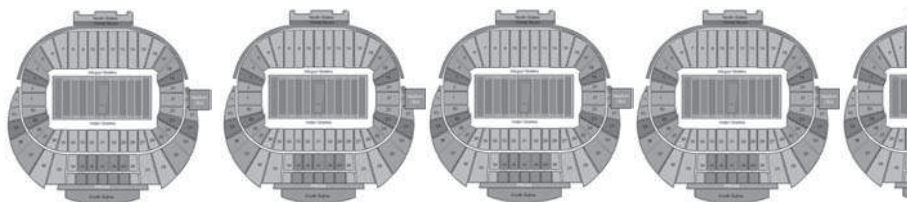


For **less than \$50** per person per year, the Library offers more than 225,000 items for checkout in-person and online, high speed internet and computer access, early literacy services, cultural and literary programs, and community meeting space.
