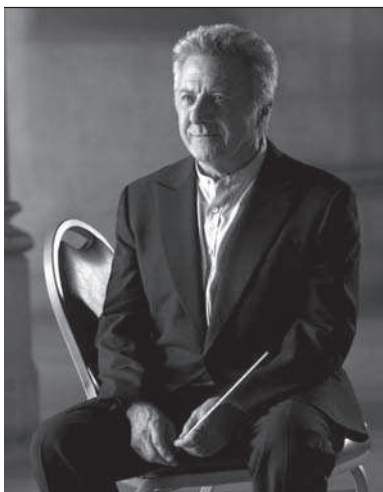

Saturday at 8 p.m. on **KVAL**

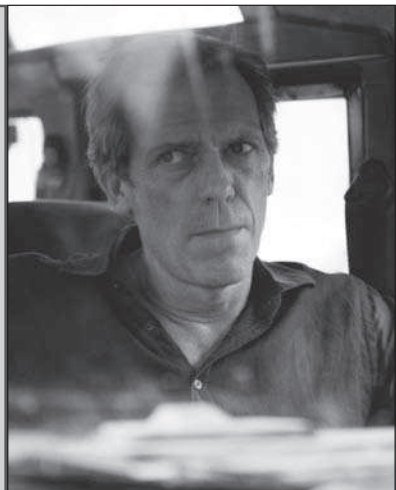

The story follows former British soldier Jonathan Pine (Hiddleston) as he traverses the shadowy political worlds of London and Washington, D.C., investigating an unholy alliance between the intelligence community and covert arms dealers, including one Richard Onslow Roper (Laurie).
