TWO STATE TITLES FOR VIKS

At the close of last weekend's OSAA 4A state track and field meet at U of O's historic Hayward Field in Eugene, Siuslaw took away some of its own bit of history with two individual state titles and a new school record.

Senior Mikaela Siegel and junior Destinie Tatum each brought home gold in their events, along with a new Siuslaw High School record in the 800 meters for Tatum.

For Siegel, it was an especially sweet victory in the 100-meter hurdles that meant retaining the crown she captured last year, along with setting the season's fastest mark in the 4A (15.61). She also currently holds the school record with last year's

MID COAST LAKES

Rainbow trout stocking is underway in many locations along the mid coast. Look at the stocking report to see the full stocking season.

Fishing for the various warm water fish species is good this time of year as fish move to the shallows for spawning. There are numerous lakes in the Florence area that can provide good opportunity and have both boat and bank access.

ALSEA RIVER:

The river is now open to cutthroat trout fishing. Casting small spinners, spoons or fly fishing streamers or dry flies can be very effective. Bait is not allowed above the head of tide until Sept. 1.

SALMON RIVER:

The river basin is open for cutthroat trout fishing. Casting small spinners, spoons or fly fishing streamers or dry flies can be very effective. Bait is not allowed above the head of tide until Sept. 1.

SILETZ RIVER: Steelhead

Steelhead fishing is slow but the summer steelhead run is underway. This run typically peaks by early July but fish can be found throughout the mainstem at any time now. Casting spinners, drifting bait or using a bobber and jig can be effective.

Cover water and fish small and simple as the river conditions are low and clear.

Cutthroat trout opened May 22 and can offer anglers of all experience levels good opportunity. Casting small spinners, spoons or fly fishing streamers or dry flies can be very effective.

SIUSLAW RIVER:

The river is now open to all fishing or cutthroat trout. This fishery can offer anglers of all experience levels good opportunity. Casting small spinners, spoons or fly fishing streamers or dry flies can be very effective.

WILSON RIVER: Steelhead, Chinook, cutthroat

Fishing for steelhead and spring Chinook is slow. More fish should be moving into the river. The water is low and clear, so
