This weekend, families throughout Oregon will have the chance to experience some of the best recreation the state has to offer as favorite fishing holes, hiking trails and camp spots are offered for free from the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) and Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD).

During the state's annual Free Fishing Weekend, June 4-5, social events are planned around the state to help families make the most of this opportunity, including free fishing for anglers of all ages.

During Free Fishing Weekend, fishing licenses, tags and endorsements are not required anywhere in Oregon.

In addition, the ODFW is making sure there are plenty of fish to catch, thanks to the release of more than 185,000 trout at 80 locations around the state by the ODFW.
