Goodwin-Chronister announced as OPB, FRAA artwork winner

Oregon Pacific Bank (OPB) and the Florence Regional Arts Alliance (FRAA) have announced that Colleen Goodwin-Chronister's artwork was selected to be permanently displayed at the bank's Florence branch, 1355

Highway 101.

Her work, which will be installed as three large oil-on-canvas paintings, is titled "Positively Florence" and will depict scenes of Historic Old Town, the Siuslaw Bridge and the Siuslaw River.

The final work will be completed and installed by Aug. 8.

Goodwin-Chronister is a very successful local artist who also was recently selected to complete one of the "Dancing with Sea Lions" sculptures, which is displayed in front of

Health care leadership training offered

On July 22, 23, 29 and 30, from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m., in Eugene (call for specific location), Eugene- and Florence-area residents can train as volunteer workshop leaders for the Living Well with Chronic Conditions program.

Volunteers will travel to Eugene for four days to receive training; Florence-area residents will be reimbursed for travel expenses.

Living Well with Chronic Conditions is a six-week workshop program developed by Stanford School of Medicine to assist adults with chronic health conditions to achieve

better health outcomes by learning important skills and information related to sleep, exercise, relaxation, nutrition, better communication with medical professionals, and more.

After they are trained, volunteers will co-teach at least one six-week workshop session per year in Florence or Eugene.

Ongoing training and technical support will be available from the program coordinator, who is based out of Eugene.

Volunteers earn a small stipend after completing each 6-week workshop. Ideal candi-

dates for this volunteer opportunity are individuals with personal experience with chronic illness (either themselves or as a caregiver for someone), an interest in working with diverse individuals in a warm, non-judgmental way, is comfortable speaking in a group, and who is comfortable following a detailed, scripted curriculum.

Input sought for waste management changes

Lane County's Waste Management Division is facing a \$1.5 million imbalance between the revenue it generates and the cost to ensure the continued and future operation of Short Mountain Landfill, the county's only permitted landfill for household and commercial wastes.

The county contracted with a professional solid waste consulting firm to

identify options to reduce costs.

Recommendations in the report include eliminating the senior discount and recycling discount programs.

The report also recommends the closure of eight rural transfer stations: Creswell, London, Mapleton, McKenzie Bridge, Rattlesnake, Sharps Creek, Swisshome and Walton.
