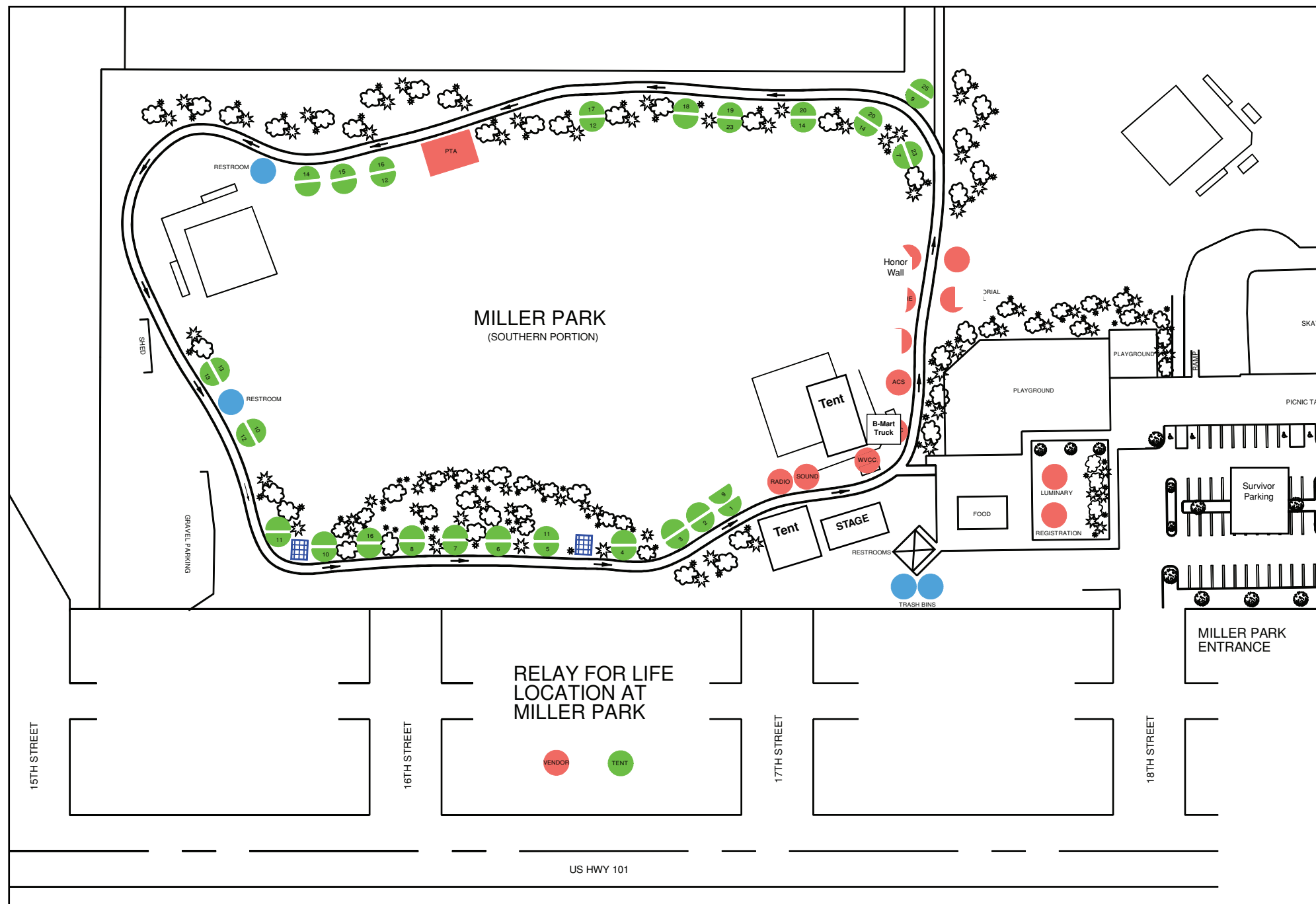


Relay For Life Rules

1. HAVE FUN!
2. All entrants must register. The team is responsible for paying its own registration fee of \$100 or getting a sponsor to pay for them and providing any other needed support, (e.g., food, rain gear, signs, shelter, etc.) Each team member is also asked to raise \$100 or more.
3. Teams establish their own schedule. One member of each team is asked to be on the track at all times.
4. NO TOBACCO OR ALCOHOLIC PRODUCTS, FIREARMS OR DOGS are allowed on the grounds.
5. Participants under 18 years of age must have a parent or chaperone in order to spend the night at the event. Parents and minors must sign the minor release form.
6. Team captains are responsible for actions of team members and families.
7. Tents may be erected in designated areas only. All teams should mark their tents with the name of their team so event officials can locate people. Teams may decorate their tents and tent area. There will be an award for the most creative decorating.
8. No extension cords across the walking track.
9. No open flames.
10. No parking in the graveled section of Oak Street behind the stage.



MILLER PARK PROCEDURES

UNLOADING

Friday — 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. • Saturday — 7 to 9 a.m. only

1. The only vehicles that can use the 18th street entrance to the park are for food court, registration, luminaria, stage set up crew, sound and electrical.
2. All other vehicles (teams, committee) may use the 15th Street entrance. From Highway 101, turn west and approximately a block up there is a green building on the right. The entrance to the track is on the back side of that building.
3. All vehicles entering the track will go clockwise only. For tent-site set up, you will have 5 minutes to unload. Then park your vehicle and return by foot to set up. Please be courteous to all the other teams setting up and limit your time to 5 minutes blocking traffic on the track.
4. No vehicles are allowed in the grass, not even to pass another vehicle.
5. The entrance at 15th street will be closed at 9 a.m. to all vehicles. All vehicles must leave the track at this time. After 9 a.m., equipment must be carried in.

RELOADING

Sunday morning after 10 a.m.

1. Vehicles should only enter the track at the 15th Street entrance after the entire tent site is torn down and packed up.
2. All vehicles entering the track will go clockwise only. You will have 5 minutes to load your vehicle. Please be courteous to all the other teams setting up and limit your time to 5 minutes blocking traffic on the track.
