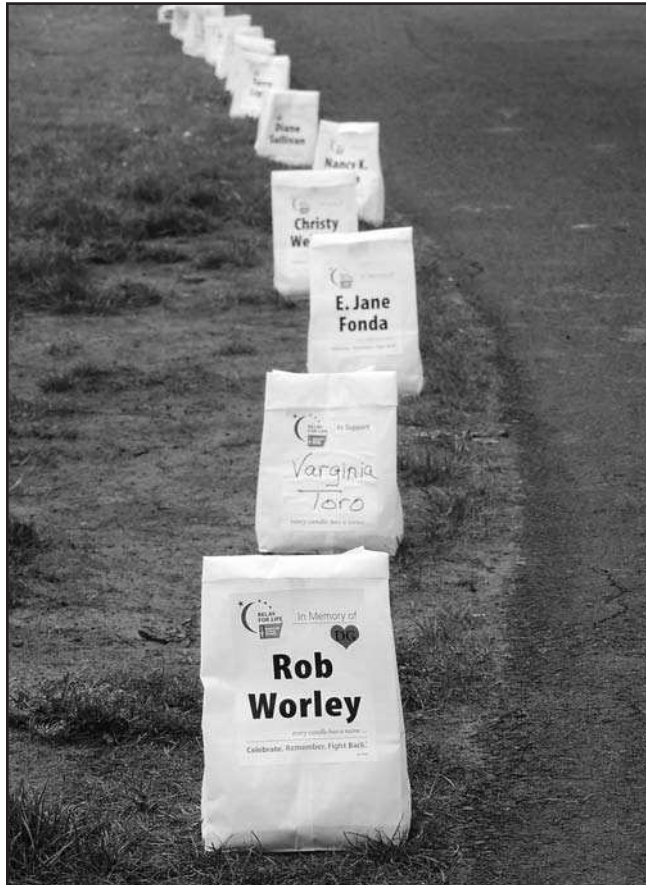


Shed light on the fight with luminarias
