ODOT summer road construction continues

ODOT is paving the 17 miles from Cooks Chasm to Sutton Creek on Highway 101, mileposts 167 to 184. Crews are also adjusting and replacing guardrails. Traffic will be controlled by flaggers and pilot car and daytime delays of up to 20 minutes are expected. The job is scheduled to be completed by mid-September.

The Siuslaw River Bridge Cathodic Protection Project continues, mileposts 190 to 191 on Highway 101. ODOT crews are making repairs to the existing concrete and reinforcement, giving a new protective coating to the bridge, adding seismic restraints, October 2016.

The project, from Torrence Road to Cornerstone Drive, mileposts 40 to 47, will include seven miles of paving, adjusting guardrails and bridgework. This will mostly be done with nightwork Sundays through Thursdays, 7 p.m. to 7 a.m., with intermittent lane closures. The project is scheduled to be completed by the end of
