Then attend the Robert's Rules of Order In-Brief Workshop on Thursday, Sept. 8, from 9 a.m. to noon at the Florence Events Center.


Dr. Russ Pierson of Lane Community College has designed this workshop for new board members, longtime members and anyone that is part of an organization or committee that holds regular meetings.
