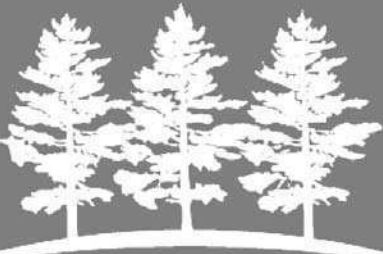
Hutton has won the last two league titles just steps ahead of Mans, who hopes to end that cycle this year.
